Rock Academy Bass Auditions

- 1. Knows the names of the open strings
- 2. Know the names of all fretted notes on all strings up to and including 7th fret
- 3. Can tune using 5th fret/open strings, or tune using 5th/7th fret harmonics
- 4. Can play a walking bassline over a I-IV-V blues progression
- 5. Can play with fingers (no pick)
- 6. Can play octaves smoothly
- 7. Can play steady 8th notes in time
- 8. Can learn and play back a note pattern
- 9. Equipment
 - a. Owns a portable amplifier (preferably a small combo), instrument cord, bass, instrument stand, and can bring this equipment to the audition, regular meetings, and gigs (instrument stand needed only for gigs)
 - b. Equipment is in good working condition and free of static, feedback, pops, and other unintentional sounds
 - c. Can demonstrate the purpose/usage of every knob/switch on the amp
 - d. Can demonstrate the purpose/usage of every knob/switch on the bass
 - e. Can demonstrate the purpose/usage of any pedalboard options (if you own and use a pedalboard)
 - f. Can produce a clean thick bass tone through the amp with no distortion
